Mr. Tinsley is a former Chief Examiner for the Delaware Department of Insurance and he is currently serving as the Special Deputy – Examinations to Insurance Commissioner Karen Weldin Stewart, CIR-ML. Prior to joining the Delaware Department of Insurance in 1985, Mr. Tinsley was a financial examiner with the Pennsylvania Insurance Department. As Chair of the NAIC's Financial Examination Scheduling and Planning Technical Group, he played a significant role in the NAIC's formal process of reviewing and evaluating the solvency of insurance companies domiciled in the United States. As Delaware's Special Deputy – Examinations he is responsible for supervising and managing the financial and market conduct examinations of insurance companies licensed and doing business in the state of Delaware.
